<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Business cards – for networking and trade show lucky prize draws. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cash – you’ll need ten \$1 & \$2 coins, two \$5 notes, and a \$10 note. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Credit cards and/or money– you might need these at the Art Gallery, Museum, Jam Factory, or in one of the restaurant precincts – Rundle St East, Hutt St, Gouger or North Tce. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carry bag – to take home all the good things you find in Adelaide. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CEFPI bags from previous events - bring yours and trade them in! 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dress-ups or dress-down – for Tuesday’s Fringe and “Mad March” dinner. Wear whatever you like, but don’t be boring! 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name tags – on anything you might misplace – bags, brollies, jackets, books etc There will be a lost property box, but this makes it easier to reunite you and your goods. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Senior’s card/ student’s card – Interstate cards work here, for public transport and for some goods and services too. Show it on bus or tram to get a “green ticket” from the driver. Or buy a metro card – and save. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take time to buy local products - Haigh’s chocolates, Menz Fruchocs, Spring Gully and Beerenberg jams, and a wide range of wines. Also available at the airport shop for last minute shoppers!
